

Andy Penkow is an award-winning alternative Country American singer-Songwriter with a unique sound, chocolate smooth but powerful voice, steeped in honesty



Studying music at JMC Academy, Andy completed an advanced diploma in popular music and performance. He was a member of the SBS Choir and a regular member of the southern school's regional performing ensemble.

Andy has released an album, an EP, and four seperate singles. He has a new album in the works with a scheduled release date in early 2022. He has seen strong commercial success having had seven singles reach Top 20 on country radio and airplay charts across Australia.

peaked at #2 on the Australian Country radio
charts and "Chasing the
Sun" was the #1 song requested on the Australian Songwriters Show for
June 2020.



 Andy's EP "Chasing the Sun", consisting of five tracks, was produced by ARIA and Golden Guitar winning producer and artist Shane Nicholson, and was released in July 2020.

 Andy has worked with many Australian country music royalty, including Golden Guitar winning duo Carter and Carter, and co-writes with multiple Golden Guitar winning artists Lyn Bowtell and Allen Caswell.

 A regular on CMT Australia and Kix Fm, Andy has also been featured on lan Mc-Namara's show on the ABC Macca and is regularly interviewed on popular radio stations across Australia.

 Andy was nominated for the 2020 APRA AMCOS TSA New Songwriter of the Year Award. "Drowning in the Whisky" won the 2019 Purple Guitar Award for best single and he also won judge's pick at the 2019 Australian busking cham-

pionships at Gundagai.

A finalist in the 2021 In-dependent Country Music Association Awards, Andy was nominated for Male Artist of the Year, Single of the Year, New Male Artists, and Music Video of the Year.
